I am writing to you to urge your support for House Resolution 1258, introduced by Congressman Dennis Kucinich, regarding the impeachment of President George W. Bush.

It is vital to our nation and our Constitution that you step forward and support a full investigation by the House Judiciary Committee into the charges of high crimes and misdemeanors committed by this President.
